

EMS WEST NOMINATING COMMITTEE
BOARD AND OFFICER SELECTION CONSIDERATIONS
(reviewed and approved 3/15/2018)

The following criteria should be considered for any individual requesting consideration for membership (new or re-election) on the EMS West Corporate Board or any elected Board or Officer position:

- Prior attendance / Committee participation (if already a member of the EMS West Corporate Board)
- County or location represented, with emphasis on geographic diversity within the 16-county region
- Agency represented, with consideration of the agency's affiliation and interaction with EMS in the region. If the candidate is not affiliated with an agency, consideration of the individual's affiliation and interaction with EMS in the region
- Number of current participants from the agency, county or location represented by the candidate, with consideration given to agencies, counties or locations that are less represented than others
- Demonstrated support of EMS West, its programs, and its efforts to improve EMS in the region
- Individual familiarity and experience in EMS generally, with consideration given to candidates who have special expertise in disciplines that support, benefit or enhance the EMS system
- PSP Criminal Background Check (no more than two years old)

Annual elections are held at the September meeting of the EMS West Corporate Board.

During July of each year, the Nominating Committee shall provide to all members of the Corporate Board a notice of upcoming elections and a Consent to Serve. Persons interested in serving as an elected officer must deliver to the Nominating Committee the Consent to Serve as well as an expression of interest in the desired position by the last business day of July, unless a different date is specified in the Consent to Serve.

Persons not currently members of the EMS West Corporate Board but who are interested in serving in such capacity should contact the Executive Director at director@emswest.org to obtain a Consent to Serve. Such interested persons must deliver to the Nominating Committee the Consent to Serve as well as an expression of interest in the desired position by the last business day of July, unless a different date is specified in the Consent to Serve.
