

For those of you that choose to maintain your National Registry Certification, as of 2018, you will need to complete the NCCP process for re-registration of your National Registry.

For the “State / Local “ approved content, Pennsylvania has defined this as ANY PA approved Continuing Education.

Pennsylvania does NOT require that you maintain your National Registry certification. Also no one is “grandfathered” into having a National Registry certification.

Pennsylvania will continue to utilize the NREMT exams at ALL levels for initial certification and for providers that are expired and choose to reinstate their certification.
